SOCIAL MEDIA CLINICS for Business Owners

These hands-on clinics will provide instruction for participants to learn and implement social media components for use in their individual businesses and as part of their marketing plans.

July 21, Introduction and Overview: Illustration of business growth opportunities through social media - overview of different types of social media and marketing strategies. Introductions to FaceBook, Twitter, Flickr, and blogging as it relates to business enhancement. This is an opportunity to address the question, "What are you afraid of?"

July 28, Focus on FaceBook: Discover the benefits of FaceBook and how to take advantage of this marketing tool. Participants will learn hands-on how to sign up for an account and create a FaceBook page, how to get fans, how to add applications to increase fan interaction, and how to use FaceBook's demographic information to inform marketing and product development.

August 4, Twitter and Flickr: Find out how to register for an account and create a professional background (Twitter) as well as how to upload photos and create an online portfolio (Flickr), and how to use both for marketing.

August 11, Blogging: *(This class is 3-6 PM.) Learn about the basic elements of a blog such as visual design, writing posts, creating a banner, and how to integrate other social media into the layout. Discussion will also include how to develop content for posts, how networking with other bloggers can help gain attention, and how to submit your blog to online directories.
